Personal data will not be disclosed to external entities, except in cases provided for by law (in particular: the National Agency of the Erasmus+ Programme and the European Solidarity Corps - Foundation for the Development of the Education System (FRSE), partner university and the receiving organization, if you are qualified to take part in the Erasmus + programme), as well as provided for in the agreements concluded between the University and service providers and technical/ organizational solutions (in particular IT service providers).
