Applications for the **BIP – Interpreting as a Tool in Business Communication** are now open! The programme was designed to equip participants (undergraduate students with a good command of English – **minimum level B2**) with the skills and knowledge necessary to navigate communicative situations requiring language mediation. During this BIP participants will gain insights into cultural nuances and etiquette to ensure accurate and effective communication in diverse settings, including health-care and community settings. Participants will also engage in practical exercises and real-world interactions to develop skills in the scope of remote and whispered interpreting.

The programme is offered in face-to-face format in which students will participate on campus (Porto Accounting and Business School – Porto Polytechnic University).

1. Before applying, talk to your International Office and make sure you can attend the complete period of the mandatory 5 days of the face-to-face course.
2. Applications from the partner universities will have priority.
3. As an undergraduate student, you're eligible to apply. You must attend both the online session and the mandatory 5 days face-to-face programme.
